

INTERNSHIP FAQ

Q: What's the Purpose of the Internship?

A: The internship experience was created to help individuals discover if a career in ministry is a passion they want to pursue. It is designed to make them more aware of their strengths, weaknesses, and identities. This program is designed for future leaders to engage in ministry firsthand, clarify their calling, and experience spiritual transformation.

A: 12 weeks

Q: Will I Be On My Own?

A: No. You will be assigned a mentor in your chosen field/track.

Q: Are There Age Limits?

A: The minimum age to apply is 17 years old.

Q: I'm Married—Am I Still Eligible?

A: Yes

Q: Where Will I Live?

A: If you need housing during your 12 weeks, we have several options that we can discuss with you.

Q: How Many Hours Per Week Are Expected?

A: Approximately 20-25 hours per week.

Q: What Does a Typical Day Look Like?

A: This is dependent on the intern track you select, however, all ministries must be present for weekend services, Mondays, and Thursdays.

Q: Will Be Hope Provide Health Insurance?

A: No health insurance coverage will be offered.

Q: Do I need a personal vehicle?

A: You will need reliable transportation to and from the church.

Q: Will I Get Paid?

A: If you are a college student, you will receive a weekly stipend.
